

## GBV Pocket Guide Training Package: Cover Note

### Overview

Building on the GBV Pocket Guide resource package, this inter-agency training package was developed to facilitate the further roll-out of the GBV Pocket Guide and GBV Pocket Guide app. The GBV Pocket Guide is now available in 21+ languages. Its utility has continued to grow since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic and has been coupled with requests for additional resources to assist staff trainings. In response to these requests from colleagues around the globe, the GBV Guidelines Implementation Support team has developed a 4-hour training package that can be delivered over one or two days (please see sample agenda, annexed).

This training package is currently available in English, French, and Spanish. Additional languages will follow depending on the availability of funds. The GBV Pocket Guide covers topics that may be distressing to some participants. It is critical to include this trigger warning in the training overview and note that training participants are free to leave at any point if they are struggling with the topic.

### Target audience

This training package is specifically designed to strengthen the capacity of ***non-GBV specialized front-line staff across all sectors*** to safely and appropriately respond to a GBV disclosures.

### Facilitator competencies

It is essential that this training be delivered by a GBV specialist who is strongly grounded in the survivor-centered approach in responding to GBV disclosures.

### Topics covered

This training package is divided into ten topics, sequenced to lay a foundational understanding of GBV in emergencies, the role of non-GBV specialized actors in responding to GBV disclosures, and subsequently covering the psychological first aid framework as in the GBV Pocket Guide. The topics covered in this training are included in the table below.
